WALTER E. WILLIAMS is John M. Olin Distinguished Professor of Economics at George Mason University in Fairfax, Virginia. He earned his Ph.D. in Economics at UCLA in 1972. Prior to his present position he taught Economics at Temple University and at California State University, Los Angeles. Between appointments he spent two years at the Urban Institute in Washington to do research on public finance, poverty, and racial discrimination.

Professor Williams is author of *America: A Minority Viewpoint*, *The State Against Blacks*, and *All It Takes Is Guts*. He has authored over 50 monographs, articles, and reviews that have appeared in many publications, and writes a nationally syndicated column carried in 80 newspapers. Professor Williams has made numerous television appearances including "Face the Nation," "Nightline," "Firing Line," "Crossfire," "Nightwatch," and has hosted the documentary "Good Intentions," based on his book, *The State Against Blacks*.
