[redacted] during the meeting advised the WFO representative that only Senator Strom Thurmond, a member of the subcommittee, is aware of the investigation he is conducting in this matter. [redacted] advised that he is interested in the identities of the KCIA agents in Washington, D. C.; the names of the congressmen the Koreans are interested in; who is assigned from the Korean Embassy to work on the Hill and their contacts. He indicated that he would also like to know the degree of penetration into Congress as well as their penetration in the Senate, U. S. Department of State and the Defense Department. He was referred to FBIHQ in regard to all of these questions.
