# JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the power of Congress to impose a tax on a failure to purchase goods or services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*  
3       *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),*

4       That the following article is proposed as an amend-  
5       ment to the Constitution of the United States, which shall  
6       be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Con-  
7       stitution when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths

1 of the several States within seven years after the date of  
2 its submission for ratification:

3 “ARTICLE—

4 “Congress shall make no law that imposes a tax on  
5 a failure to purchase goods or services.”.
